Earn Your Angel Wings

Dear Friends,

Economically we are all in the same boat. But some are in the bottom of that boat and could use a hand. Often people don't understand MCAVHN's mission and it doesn't feel very "soft and cuddly". But we are asking for your help in continuing that mission and it's expansion over the years. We are looking for ANGELS like you.

MCAVHN case manages about 200 individuals in this County who are affected by HIV/AIDS and/or Hepatitis C. Many misunderstand our clients — they have been kept on the very fringes of society—but I assure you these are remarkable people. Yes, some have come to their present circumstances through the need to numb both physical and emotional pain, or because they made poor choices on the road to seeking connection. But does this really matter now? These are folks with families, they belong to your church, they work in your community. Some come to us homeless and we help to find them housing so that they can start the hard journey towards health. We open our ears and our hearts, help them with forms, help ensure they get healthy food, encourage good habits, and asist them to adhere to very challenging medical regimes.

We also run a Syringe Exchange and understand that some may think this abets and condones addiction. We assure you, without question, it helps reduce the incidence of AIDS and HEPC in our community and keeps dangerous used needles off the streets and out of the parks where our loved ones could be hurt. It also brings active users into contact with people who really care and don't judge— often a very first step to recovery. We have several hundred testimonials that will speak to that. We do all this with three part time counselors/case managers and several wonderful volunteers. However, none of our small grants pay for the basics— our part time office manager, our rent, our utilities, our telephones/internet, paper, pens ... Our rent alone is \$12,600. a year. Thankfully, we have recently received a generous anonymous donation to help us buy supplies, and to continue our Harm Reduction program into 2012 and beyond.

So, we are asking (begging) for your help to pay some of these costs. Earn your Angel Wings. Please put a check of any denomination in an envelope and send it. Call your friends, neighbors, families, club members, and urge them to do the same. Perhaps a small group of friends or a family could pay for one month of rent (\$1050.) Last year five wonderful donors helped pay the rent for several months. Or, your group may want to pay a phone bill (approx. \$250. a month since we reduced our service). We have done all possible to reduce costs, cutting staff time to the bone, and all staff volunteering extra hours.

MCAVHN has been serving Mendocino County since 1987. We have nothing to show except the improvement in the lives of those we serve— all our resources are focused on caring for people, and giving those who need it a leg up to becoming more active, creative and giving members of our community.
