MCAVHN's Beautiful Heart Transformed My Life-Tim's Story

Tim Dobler's first encounter with MCAVHN was through the syringe exchange program when he was a homeless IV drug user. Then after a period of incarceration he made a conscious choice to get help and became a MCAVHN client in the ROSOC (Recovery Oriented System of Care) program. Tim also credits Drug Court for helping turn his life around. He now has a beautiful apartment with his fiancée (also a MCAVHN client), is celebrating his first birthday (first year clean and sober), has a part time job with Sonoma Sweepers and volunteers his time helping others at Hospice and Plowshares as well as at MCAVHN.

Tim was our featured speaker at the Event of the Heart. He offered his deepest gratitude to the staff of MCAVHN, emphasizing the "beautiful heart" of those who have helped him and literally saved his life. In Tim's words:

To Dr. Libby Guthrie I would like to say that your incredible insight and empathy have changed my life. My first unofficial diagnosis came through you. After a referral to mental health from MCAVHN I was officially diagnosed with severe manic-bipolar disorder. Today I am on medication, stable, meeting regularly with a psychiatrist and a therapist. A thirty year cycle of drug addiction, homelessness, pain and confusion has been broken. The course of my life has forever been changed. Words fail to express the gratitude that I have toward the loss of absolute hopelessness. You have a beautiful heart.

To Ms. Joann Brewer: From the first day I was drawn to you like family. You have a very grounded and wise-for-your-years approach. My frustrations have always been calmed by your smile, a smile like a Cheshire cat, because you always have a

solution along with the smile. You helped me navigate my way through this new life as my case manager. At first you had to help me keep each appointment because I could not remember them. This winding road has been marked by your help. From the Buddy Eller Center through the housing maze, my disability nightmare and everything from food to finances: You were there. You were the one. Thank you Jo Jo for all that you are and all that you do. Your warmth and enthusiasm are priceless. You have a beautiful heart.

To Mr. John Weber, a man of character and integrity: Your people skills, dedication and knowledge cannot be replaced. You probably know best how MCAVHN has helped me. I remember when you used to serve me in the syringe exchange. You have seen me from then till now. I am but one of many (that you have helped). You do your work from the kindness of your heart and that, sir, is a beautiful heart. Thank you for being you.

There are also many administrators, directors and volunteers who follow suit to these amazing people.

Tonight I was asked to articulate just HOW MCAVHN has helped me. I could say that MCAVHN helped me transform my life with housing, food support, information, case management, friendship and a safe place to be. While all of this is the absolute truth, I feel there is even more. HOW the staff at MCAVHN helped me was with dignity, trust, being unconditional. HOW they helped me was with respect, not judging me, with tolerance and patience. HOW they helped me was with love and kindness. HOW they helped me was with a beautiful heart.
